**RULES:**

1. Rules as per the PCA (Pony Club Australia) 2021 National Tetrathlon rules with a few scoring modifications to create the unofficial 'Have a Go' events.
2. 1 horse 1 rider – 1 rider 1 horse for Tetrathlon.
3. Age is as at 1 Jan 2021 (to match PCA rules).
4. By nominating for this event, you agree not to leave until after presentation of awards.
5. No rider is to have their phone on them while mounted. If you are seen with your phone on you while mounted you will be eliminated for the day.
6. All COVID requirements must be followed by all competitors and spectators while on the grounds.

**DISPUTES:**

All complaints should be made to: - Technical Delegate. The complaint will be adjudicated accordingly, and a Dispute Committee may be called if required. The complaint must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes and be accompanied by a fee of \$100.

**RESERVATION OF RIGHTS: -**

The Organisers reserve the right

- (a) To cancel any class or event
- (b) To divide any class, or if less than 3 competitors combine classes
- (c) To alter the advertised times
- (d) To refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
- (e) To transfer competitors between sections of a class

**BIOSECURITY AND RISK ASSESSMENT PLANS;**

In the event of horse movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance, and cost of their horse/horses. Including and not limited to feeding and watering and vet cost for the time of the restriction. An up to date BIOSECURITY PLAN and RISK ASSESSMENT PLAN will be available at the Club House.

**OTHER**

1. Enclosed shoes (that do not cover the anklebone) are compulsory for the Shooting Phase.
2. Swim caps are required for the Swimming Phase.
3. Phase schedules to be confirmed and communicated prior via SGVPC Facebook Event.
4. One event helper per family is mandatory. By nominating you are also agreeing to help with an appropriate event role assigned by the committee, or your entry will be forfeited.
5. Limited yards available. Horses cannot be left at floats without vehicles attached. Please organise your own car-pooling to swimming pool (less than 5 mins drive) if possible.

**UNOFFICIAL CLASSES SCORING EXPLAINED (SEE TABLES BELOW)**

1. Each competitor enters their appropriate age class and can choose which heights and distances they are capable of. Maximum points are available as displayed in the table, but points will be deducted from the maximum for time over the optimum time.
2. The team event will run in conjunction with the individual event.
3. A competitor can enter in both the individual event and the team event. If competing in both, the score from the individual entry will count towards the team's score.
4. Competitors can be in multiple teams.
5. Only full riding PCAQ members can compete in the riding phase.
6. Day membership fee of \$7 and waiver will be required to compete in the Run, Swim or Shoot phase for anyone that is not a current riding PCAQ member.
7. Parent/Child competitors will score based on their age/distance selected.
