

## **OFFICIALS for TETRATHLON DAY(s)**

- Please submit this form to the Tetrathlon Sub-Committee **at least 3 weeks before** the proposed date of the event. Any change in judges should be advised immediately
- The **Tet TD** should be on the official PCQ Tet TD list or approved by Tetrathlon Sub-committee.
- **Ride phase Judges** should be on the official PCQ List or be EA accredited. The rules are very different for Tetrathlon jumping and so the Judge needs to be informed at the time of appointing them and a copy of the riding phase penalties and rules need to be provided to them at this time. They are more complex and therefore need time to become familiar.
- **Course Builders (CB)** should be on the official PCQ List or be EA accredited. If EA accredited, please state their EA accreditation besides their name. If cross country fences intend to be used in the ride phase (a Derby Course or pure Cross Country) then the CB needs to hold a minimum Zone level CB accreditation and have extensive knowledge of how to secure Cross country fences.

- ❖ 2x Tet TD's who split the responsibility. Typically, where 2x Tet TD are used, one Tet TD has responsibility for the: run, swim and shoot and the second Tet TD for the ride, although a 50/50 split is also possible. The Ride TD must be an approved Show jumping TD.
