Initially applications are open to ALL Zones or Clubs. The rotation will only operate if there is one or more applications for the Event and one of those applications is from the 'Rotation' Region

2024 Formal Gymkhana, Sporting, Stockman's Challenge, Campdraft and Mounted Games Championships

Will be held in the September School holidays in the **Southern Area**. Zones 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 12, 13, 20, 21, 26 and 28. PCQ subsidy towards the running of these events to be advised.

2024 Dressage, Combined Training & Horse Trials

Will be held in the **July School Holidays** in the **Central Area**. Zones 7, 9, 10, 14, 15, 16 and 27. PCQ subsidy towards the running of these events to be advised.

2024 Jumping Equitation and Showjumping Championships

As per the Minutes of the State Showjumping Sub-committee - 5th June 2023
Zone 18 advised they will not be applying to host State the Jumping Equitation & Showjumping 2024, however would like an opportunity for 2025. Applications now open to any region.

As per the Minutes of the State Showjumping Sub-committee 05 May 2022

"When it is the rotation in the Northern area, the zone/club in the northern area has the option to run it in the September holidays. If no application has been taken up by the AGM, applications are then open to the State to run the event in the Easter holidays"

Rotation for 2024 is the **Northern Area**. Zones 11, 18, 22, 23 and 25.
