



Application to Host PCQ Masters' Championship Event

This is open to all Clubs and Zones to submit an application to host these Championships. PCQ subsidy towards the running of this event to be advised. Please note, that this is the only financial support which PCQ will provide.

The Event host accepts full responsibility for the organizing and conducting of the relevant State Event.

Below is some information which may be of assistance:

- First Masters was hosted by Oakey Pony Club in November, 2019. They chose to do Sporting, Campdraft and Combined Training. Age groups for the first two disciplines were 26 – 29 Years, 30 – 39 Years, 40 – 49 Years and 50 Years and Over. For Combined Training, a Preliminary test was done and then the groups were divided by the jumping height
- It is suggested that either two or three disciplines, of your choice, be selected
- The age groups above are not prescriptive, but what was chosen for the inaugural event
- Feedback from the 2019 event, suggested that it would be best to do this over a long weekend, if doing three disciplines. Additionally, the organising Club or Zone would need to ensure there were adequate helpers.

Every applicant must have their venue inspected by a member of the State CIP. The signed checklist and letter of approval of the venue's suitability is to accompany the application.
