TWO HORSE RULE – Riders may enter 2 horses in the same or different heights. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.

MOBILE PHONES: Riders are not to carry on their person any mobile phone whilst mounted.

PROTESTS – Must be in writing within 30 minutes of incident, accompanied by \$50. Only the owner, his authorised agent, or the rider of the horse taking part in the competition is entitled to lodge a protest. Disputes committee to consist of PCAQ Technical Delegate, Chief Steward and One Judge.

WORKERS - SETUP – Zone 1 Clubs are reminded that this is a Zone event and they must supply two willing workers for the working bee to be held on Saturday 31st of August. Workers to nominate online. Failure to attend this working bee will result in the club riders competing HC.
