# FEATURE EVENT:

## Top Score Competition - Article 270

12 under: 70cm Max height. (30-70cm)

13 and over: 90cm Max height (40-90cm)

\$5 entry per horse rider combo.

Will be run shortly after show jumping presentation into the evening if required under lights.

First place prize only. Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> in both age groups.

- Summary: Obstacles will have a point value depending on the difficulty / higher/ oxers. Riders will know of the points at walking course. Aim is to within the time allocated and to jump as many jumps as possible in your own order. Jumps can be jumped twice. Some jumps may only be able to be jumped one way. Joker jump will be in the course carries a high value point to jump clear but if knocked down loses you points. There is no jump off for this competition.

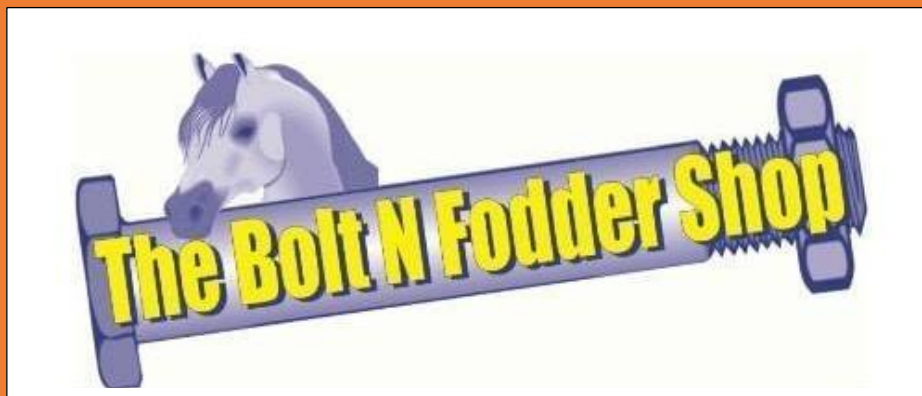


## Show Jumping Details:

- Run under 2024 PCAQ Showjumping rules: 2024 National Gear rules apply:
- Nominations received in official classes who do not have performance card on the day will compete HC.(HorConcor). If the competitor does not have the card, any awards won for the day should be withheld until the card is sighted and the results recorded.
- A horse may compete in only one height for the day at an Official competition.
- Maximum 2 horses per rider, can compete either the same height class (please note if low nominations need to be ready to ride back-to-back) or different height classes. Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards.
- Seniors to nominate what height they are riding in after nominating online. Email chosen height to [moondargaponyclub@hotmail.com](mailto:moondargaponyclub@hotmail.com). If not stated will be placed in 70cm class.
- Combined Groups: Where insufficient entries are received in a particular class, it will be run as per rules for Combined Groups in rule book.
- Performance cards: Are required for All riders in class 1-9 inclusive. Cards to be presented to the Organising Secretary before the commencement of event.
- Disclaimer: Neither the Organising Committee of this event to which these rules apply, nor PCAQ accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, and spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- Reservation of Rights: The Organising Committee reserves the right to: a. To cancel any class or event b. To divide any class c. To combine classes if less than 3 competitors and the rules governing combining groups d. To alter advertised times e. To transfer competitors between sections of a class f. To refuse any entry with or without stating a reason
- Draw will be sent out by the Friday morning prior. Riders will ride in order of the draw no exceptions.
- Stables need to be nominated for and will be allocated. Camping permitted, limited powered sites available.
- Formal Club attire required for all age groups except under 13 years 20-30cm, rally shirt is permitted.
- Horse health declarations must be submitted prior to riding.
- First aiders in the first aid and gear check tent.
- Unofficial classes 11,12, will likely run in a separate ring if numbers permit.
- Late nominations: Is at the discretion of the organising committee. Late nominations will not be accepted into classes that at time of nominations closing had no entries. Once the draw is out no nominations will be added.

- Failure to attend presentation at end of day will result in forfeiting prizes and trophies, these will then be awarded to the next place getter. Presentation to be in club uniform.

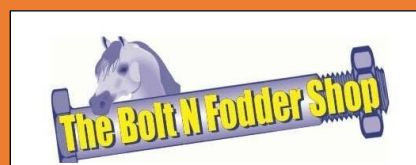
Jumping: Under 13 Ideal Time. Over 13: AM7 (art 238-2.4 option B, table A)

### Awards:

Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place for each event.

Overall awards: For all classes except under 7s led. Scoring: Placings to 10<sup>th</sup> for points.

All under 7's led receive a gift bag.





### Gymkhana details:

- Disclaimer: Neither the Organising Committee of this event to which these rules apply, nor PCAQ accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, and spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- Reservation of Rights: The Organising Committee reserves the right to: a. To cancel any class or event b. To divide any class c. To combine classes if less than 3 competitors and the rules governing combining groups d. To alter advertised times e. To transfer competitors between sections of a class f. To refuse any entry with or without stating a reason
- Only 1 horse to be ridden for the day.
- Horse health declarations must be submitted prior to riding.
- Height of jumping:
  - Under 7 option to do bounce pony instead of jumping or 30cm
  - Under 9's 30cm
  - 9-11 years 40cm
  - 11-13 years 50cm
  - 13-15 years 60cm
  - 15-17 years 70cm
  - 17-26 years 80cm
  - Seniors pick own height - slot in with other age groups on the day.
- Overall champion and reserve for all age groups except for under 7's.
- Each rider must have a designated helper to help with judging, scoring/ timekeeping, age group for gymkhana.
- Formal club attire to be worn for the event except for the under 7's age group. Under 7s any long sleeve shirt and long pants will be accepted.
- Hendra Vaccination not compulsory
- First aider in the first aid and gear check tent.
- Failure to attend presentation at end of day will result in forfeiting prizes and trophies, these will then be awarded to the next place getter. Presentation to be in club uniform.
- Any led rider (no matter of age) can be in the under 7s led group - noncompetitive group

- Seniors to gain points for Show jumping must jump a minimum of 50cm.
