- Completed Horse Health Declaration to be submitted online using the QR code or to be handed in to the office upon arriving. As a condition of entry, each rider MUST provide a helper, dressage penciller, gate steward or rail steward.
- Riders may enter a second competitive horse but if in the same class you need to consider ride times will be close.
- Competitors must compete in full pony club uniform and also be in uniform to collect awards. Presentation is at the end of the day and winners are to bring horses for sponsor photos with Rugs.
- Disclaimer: Neither the organising committee of any contest to which these rules apply, nor the PCQ accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- The organising committee reserves the right to (a) cancel any class or event (b) to divide any class (c) to alter the advertised times (d) to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason (e) to transfer competitors between sections of a class (f) to combine class if less than 3 competitors.
- Refunds - Only before close of entries. After close of entries 18th October, refunds only with receipt of a veterinary or medical certificate less an administration fee. No Refunds for nomination fee after draw is published. In the event of COVID restrictions or an extreme weather event there will be an administration fee held if event is cancelled.
- Official 12yrs & Under riders may compete on any grade of horse provided that it is their normal pony club mount.
- Riders in Classes CT1 -CT14 must produce performance cards to the office prior to 8am on day of competition unless other arrangements have been made with the organising committee. If rider does not have performance card on the day of competition, ribbons and trophies can be withheld until it is produced. Nominations that do not have Horse Registration number and riders who do not have performance card on the day, will compete HC.
