- \* Horse Health Declarations and Performance Cards to be handed in on arrival. Competitors in Official classes must provide their performance card or registration number, or will ride HC.
- \* Class 10; Seniors can choose their own height when nominating. If not stated, will be placed in Class 5 80cm. Seniors must compete in Class 4 to 9 to be eligible for overall prizes
- \* Riders must provide their own bridle numbers
- \* This event is a 2025 State Qualifier
- \* Two horse rule applies
- \* Event will be run in accordance with current national Showjumping Rules and Gear Check Rules
- \* Competitors must have a gear check before each round
- \* Mobile Phones are not to be used while mounted
- \* Biosecurity and Covid plans will be in place
- \* Disputes to be lodged with the organizing secretary accompanied with \$50 and within 30 mins of the event completing
- \* Raffle will be held at the completion of the day
- \* Electric timers will be in use.
- \* Coffee Van will be in attendance from early morning and canteen will be open and eftpos will be available
