- ✓ Riders may enter two horses as per the Two Horse Rule for each discipline
- ✓ Assisted Classes - Non Competitive. Riders can be led, can follow or can be directed from inside or outside of the arenas. All riders will receive a prize, there will be no placings. Riders will receive a paper test for the dressage phases of the events.



You will need to supply your own Bridle or Back Number for each event over the weekend
