RULES & CONDITIONS

CONDITIONS:

Two Horse Rule: A competitor may ride two horses in the same or different heights. Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards.

Seniors: To be eligible for Overall Senior Award, Seniors choose from Class 4-9 inclusive.

Combined Groups: Where insufficient entries are received in a particular class, it will be run as per rules for Combined Groups in rule book.

Pre-filled Performance cards: Are required for All riders in class 1-9 inclusive, except seniors.

RULES:

1. The judges decision is final in all events
2. Disputes are to be lodged within 30minutes of the completion of any event and must be accompanied by a \$50 fee.
3. All competitors must wear an approved helmet and be suitably attired in Pony Club Uniform.
