the day

Rules

- To be judged under current 2024 PCQ rules for Showjumping
- All competitors must be a current riding member of PCQ or PCA
- Competitors ride at their own risk under the rules of PCQ
- All clubs with 3 or more riders must provide a helper for the event
- The judge's decision is final in all events
- Disputes are to be lodged within 30 minutes of the completion of any event and must be accompanied by a \$50 fee
- All competitors mut wear an approved helmet, formal pony club uniform and gear as directed by PCA 2024 Gear Check Guidelines
- Rider must be financial members of an affiliated Pony Club on day of competition
- Nominations received without a horse registration number and who do not have a performance card on the day will compete HC.

Conditions

Two Horse Rule – A competitor may ride two horses in the same or different heights within age group – each horse is eligible to be placed in each class for Overall Awards

Seniors – To be eligible for overall Senior Award, seniors must choose from classes 4-9

Combined Groups – Where insufficient entries are received in a particular class, it will be run as per rules for Combined Groups in the rule book

Pre-filled Performance Cards – Are required for classes 1-9. Cards are to be presented at registration before the commencement of the event with details of each class

Reservation of Rights

The organising committee reserves the right to:

- cancel any class or event
- to alter advertised times
- to refuse any entry with or without stating the reason
- to transfer competitors between sections of a class
- to combine classes if less than 3 competitors and the rules governing combining groups

Disclaimer: Neither the Organising Committee of this event to which these rules apply, nor the PCQ accepts any liability for any accidents, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

Biosecurity

All horse owners and competitors should be aware that you have a biosecurity obligation to take all reasonable steps to ensure your activities do not spread pest, disease or containment. Horse/s with signs of illness should not be brought to our grounds. Competitors are required to advise event organisers if a horse falls ill. In the unlikely event of a horse movement restrictions, everyone will be expected to remain at the venue until cleared to leave. Each participate will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horse/s. Including and not limited to feeding, watering and vet costs for the time of restriction. Our Biosecurity plan is available in our Club House.
