#### **Rules:**

- 1. Teams of 3 riders made up from financial PCA riding members.
- 2. One rider per phase, i.e., Rider A does the dressage, Rider B the Derby, Rider C the Show jumping.
- 3. Teams must nominate a name e.g.: "The Misfits"
- A rider may have three rides in three different teams but can only ride the derby phase once on the same horse.
- 5. A rider can do multiple rounds of showjumping in different teams. That can be the same class or 2 consecutive classes/heights on the same or different horse.
- 6. A rider may ride multiple dressage tests in different teams on the same horse or a different horse in the same class or different class.
- 7. The horse must not be ridden by another rider.
- 8. In the dressage phase, horses can only compete one level below their dressage grading. Eg an elementary horse can only ride a novice test.
- 9. No callers in the dressage phase except for class 1. Whips are allowed in the dressage phase.
- 10. In the derby phase, horses can only compete one level below their eventing grading.
- 11. Competitors with a SJ performance card cannot compete in the SJ phase class 1 and 2.
- 12. Club or zone uniform is to be worn. A club or zone polo shirt may be worn in the Derby phase.
- 13. Back protectors and medical armbands must be worn in the derby phase.
- 14. A graded horse may be ridden by a non-graded rider in a lower class.
- 15. 12 and under riders who compete unofficial ODE or showjumping can compete in class 1. 12 and under riders who compete in 60cm ODE or 60cm/70cm showjumping can compete in any of the showjumping and derby phases in class 2 and 3. 12 & under riders who compete 80cm ODE or 80cm SJ can compete in the showjumping or derby phases of class 3 and 4.
- 16. Seniors may form a team or join a team with junior and associate members in classes 2, 3, 4 or 5.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or event; to divide any class; to alter the advertised times; to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason; to transfer competitors between sections of a class; to combine classes if less than 3 teams and to alter or amend the program as necessary.

Dogs: Dogs are not permitted on the grounds – no exceptions.

Canteen: Canteen facilities will be available for the duration of the event.

BACK NUMBERS: Bridle numbers can be worn in the dressage and showjumping phases. Riders to supply their own back number for the derby.

**DRESSAGE:** Approximate start time at 8:00 am but subject to change depending on numbers. No callers allowed, except for class 1

**SHOWJUMPING:** Commencing at approx. 1:00 pm with class 1 but subject to change. Judged under Table A rules as per horse trials.

**DERBY:** To start at approx. 9:00 am with class 5. Time penalties as per PCQ Horse Trials rule book 2024 Competitors are <u>not</u> permitted to wear a watch.

#### **Derby Penalties**

5 for a knockdown of a showjumping obstacle in the derby phase 10 for first disobedience at any obstacle

20 for second disobedience at same obstacle Elimination for third disobedience at the same obstacle

Elimination for total of 4 disobediences on the whole course Elimination fall of horse or rider
