Burnett Zone 7 are excited to invite Teams to compete in this event, to be held at Maryborough Showgrounds and Equestrian Park, Bruce Highway, Maryborough. We would like to invite your Zone to join us in what we feel is a competition run in true Pony Club spirit.

Zones must put forward teams to compete. Individuals need to comply with whatever process your zone has to join a team. Zones will forward the Teams to us on a spreadsheet that will be sent to them. The Zone will not collect your fees, this will be paid via Nominate. You can only be in 1 team.

You will be responsible for your nominations via Nominate. Facility fee, Camping and Stabling are booked via Nominate with the fees going directly to MSEP. Stable bonds are refunded if MSEP are satisfied that your stable has been left clean.

Online Nominations close 3rd October 2024

If zones have riders keen to compete but can't put together a full team it is possible for composite teams to be put together. Teams of 3 riders may take part.

Seniors are permitted to enter in the 13 & Over classes. HOWEVER, teams must not contain more than 2 senior riders.

Due to a lack of lighting, we will not be running the Puissance.

Saturday 7:30am walk the course, start at 8:00am AM5, Art 238.2.2, Super Two Phase, Art 274.2.1 & 2.5

Sunday 7:30am walk the course, start at 8:00am AM6, Art 273.3.2.4.4 and presentations

Each Zone may enter any number of teams in each age group, but only 1 team per rider.

TEAM MANAGERS

- Each Zone should appoint a Team Manager who is responsible for all members of his/her zone at all times. In addition, Zones should appoint Assistant Managers for each team attending, who will be responsible for his/her team at all times.
- Only Assistant Managers may walk the courses with their team.
- Zone Team Manager to advise before the start of competition any substitution of riders or horses in their teams.
- Any approach to organisers for any reason whatsoever must be made through the Team Manager.
- Protests must be lodged through the Team Manager within 30 minutes of results being displayed. Fee of \$50 is only refundable if the protest is upheld.
- Team Manager from each Zone to be responsible for collection and return of back numbers.
- A Team Managers meeting will be held on Friday afternoon at the Cane and Cattle Bar.

Please bring Zone banners for mounted presentation.

No electric fences allowed

Dogs must be on a lead at all times and kept in the camping area. No dogs are allowed around the stables or competition areas.
