UNOFFICIAL CLASSES and Seniors: Rosettes - 1st – 4th places.

Performance Cards: Both Jumping Equitation and Show Jumping cards to be pre-filled and handed to the office, prior to start of competition.

Horse health declaration: To be completed via Nominate or handed to office, prior to start of competition.

CONDITIONS:

1. To be run under Pony Club rules.
2. Open to all Pony Club Members.
3. The organising committee reserves the right to alter the program of events or Conditions if deemed necessary.
4. Two Horse Rule: Jumping Equitation and Show Jumping- Riders may enter two competitive horses in the same or different heights. Both may gain qualifying results.
5. Disclaimer: Neither the Organising Committee of this event to which these rules apply, nor PCAQ accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, and spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
6. Every rider to supply a helper to assist with course changes and rail stewarding for your age group.
7. **All camp sites & day parking areas to be left free of rubbish & manure.**
