Zones will be sent notification of your nomination. If the nomination is not endorsed by the Zone the nomination will be rejected. No pending qualifications will be accepted. Please refer to PCQ rules for qualification requirements or contact your Zone for clarification.

Refunds: Entry fees will be refunded if the Organising Secretary is advised before the advertisement of the draw. Such advice of withdrawal must be accompanied by Vet/Medical Certificate, up to 10% of the entry fee may be retained to cover administration fees.

Stabling/Yards: **\$30 per horse per night**

Stable Bond: **\$50 per stable, refunded by Nominate after the event if left clean**

- Cost includes sawdust
- No companion horses
- Manure to be put in designated areas
- All stables/yards will be allocated. Anyone moving stables/yards without express permission of the stabling manager will be in breach of the biosecurity plan and will be asked to leave the grounds.
- Stables/yards must be left clean on departure – free of manure, urine, sodden sawdust and feed or your bond will be forfeited.

Camping: **\$30 per campsite per night**

Dogs are permitted on leash in the camping area only. No dogs to be in the competition area, warm up areas or stable area. Loose dogs will be impounded by Council.

NB: No riding of electric scooters is permitted anywhere on the grounds at any time.

PCQ Horse health declaration form must be handed in on arrival. In case of a lock down, the responsibility and expenses incurred at this event will rest with the owners of the animals.

Competitors must provide their pre-filled Performance Cards in a timely manner to their relevant Team Manager for presentation at the meeting:

Covid: Do not attend if you are unwell or showing flu like symptoms. Any restrictions as advised by Qld Health at the time of the event will be adhered to.

Catering: The canteen will be operating from WTPC clubhouse for the duration of the event, serving breakfast from 7am and closing at approx. 5pm each evening.

Supplies: Toowoomba is a large, rural community with plenty of options for groceries and other amenities and supplies

Horse Feed: QPD – Queensland Produce Distributors – 4633 1011. Hay, chaff and other feed requirements will be available. Daily delivery service will be available (not Sunday).

Stock Inspections: Competitors must make their own arrangements in relation to this. NB the Toowoomba Showgrounds is in a tick-free zone

Nominated helpers: Zones will be required to supply helpers throughout the event. Please note that if helpers are not provided by their Zone their riders will not be allowed to compete. Zones will be allocated roles and these will be advised at Team Manager meetings.

Safety: Whilst an official gear check will be carried out, the safety of rider's gear is ultimately the responsibility of the competitor and/or parent/guardian.

Disclaimer: Neither the organising committee of this event nor PCQ accepts any liability for any damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

Reservation of Rights: The organising committee reserves the right to:

- a) Cancel any class or event
- b) Divide any class
- c) Alter the advertised times
- d) Refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
- e) Transfer competitors between sections of a class
- f) Combine classes if less than 3 competitors

Rules

1. All competitions will run according to PCQ rules. Team Managers and competitors are expected to be familiar with all applicable rules of PCQ.
2. GEAR RULES: 2025 PCA National Gear Rules apply. It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure they are familiar and compliant with these rules: <https://ponyclubaustralia.com.au/sports/national-gear-rules/>
3. BACK NUMBERS: The Zone Team Manager will be responsible for the collection and return of back numbers. Back numbers not returned at the end of competition will be billed to Zones at \$100/bib.
4. ORDER OF START: Competitors will ride in the order of the draw. The draw will be in the program and available at the event. Riders must be prepared to ride earlier if there are scratchings.
5. ENTRY ONLINE: Incorrect or misleading information will incur elimination. Individuals nominate and pay online. Qualifiers will be validated for accuracy.
6. ZONES: Zone secretaries will be required to confirm support of the list of nominations for their zone. They will also need to provide contact details for zone team managers.
7. TWO HORSE RULE: Two horse rule will apply as per relevant rule books. Riders may change horses between Jumping Equitation and Showjumping. (PCQ rule 20: Mounts in general rules applies)
8. ZONE TEAM MANAGER: Each Zone will appoint a Team Manager for each discipline. Their duties shall be:
 - Responsible for all team members whilst at the event.
 - Inspect uniforms and gear of competitors before they report to gear steward.
 - Responsible for lodging of protest, which must be made in writing within one hour of the incident or of results being posted accompanied with a \$50 fee
 - Responsible for the back numbers and their return
 - Assemble riders and required horses for presentation as directed by Organising Committee
 - Collect and submit grading cards - **Please prefill performance cards before submitting at the team managers meeting**
 - Ensure that zone duties are fulfilled
 - Ensure that all competitors are present at Presentation
9. PRESENTATION: For presentation of awards at the conclusion of a state fixture it is the Team Manager's responsibility to assemble all competitors/mounts in full uniform, ribbon winners or not for the final parade as directed by the organizing committee. An unmounted assembly may be organised at the discretion of the committee in extenuating circumstances.

Request for special permission to leave must be made in writing by the Zone Team Manager and may be granted by the Judge in Chief and the Chief Steward in exceptional circumstances. Presentation of ribbons for completed rounds will take place at the discretion of the committee, the Judge in Chief and

the Chief Steward.

10. **EXERCISE:** Competitors may only exercise their horses in the areas provided. The nominated rider is the only person who can lunge their horse at a competition. Riders under 14 years may have an adult lunge their horse or assist for safety reasons.

Riders disregarding this rule could incur disqualification from the event. Competitors must not ride on or near any part of the official courses prior to the competition. Horses must be correctly saddled and the competitor must wear a helmet, riding boots and competition number whilst exercising their horse.

11. **JUMPING EQUITATION CLASSES:** If numbers in any class are insufficient, classes may be combined. Groups of over 30 riders but less than 40 riders may be divided into two groups, but will be divided if numbers exceed 40. If there are less than 3 riders in any group the riders do not form part of a team (Zone or State).

12. **TEAMS:** Riders in all groups will be included in the State and Zone Teams where applicable. Refer to scoring handbook for more detailed method of scoring for teams in each discipline.

Awards

PERPETUAL TROPHIES

Perpetual trophies remain the property of PCQ; names will be engraved at the conclusion of the event.

REPLICA TROPHIES

Awarded to members of winning Zone & State Teams.

CHAMPIONSHIP RUGS

Presented to the winners of each Height/Age Group.

MEDALLIONS

Medallions will be presented to 3rd place in Age Group/Height Championship.

SASHES

To 10th place overall in each height/age group

To 3rd place in Zone teams (Qld zones only)

To 1st place in winning State team

RIBBONS

To 10th place in each round of the competition

STATE POLO SHIRT

Members of the Queensland State Team are entitled to receive a Maroon State Polo Shirt from PCQ. Club Secretaries are to apply to PCQ giving the size required within two weeks of the fixture.
