ALL CLASSES TO RUN UNDER JUMPING <u>EQUITATION & SHOWJUMPING RULES BOOK UPDATED</u>
01.12.2023, PCA GEAR CHECK BOOK UPDATED DEC 24, EFFECTIVE 01.01.2025

BRIDLE NUMBERS TO BE USED ON BOTH JUMPING EQUITATION & SHOWJUMPING EVENTS

Gear check required between both Equitation rounds & between each 1st round in Showjumping

Riders may enter two horses in the same OR different classes

Each horse may gain qualifying results.

Each horse will be placed in its class and eligible for overall awards.

All current Covid & Bio security requirements will be met at the time of the event.

NO DOGS permitted on Grounds.

Combined groups: Where insufficient entries are received, it will be run as per the combined group rule in the rule book

<u>Performance Cards</u>: Required for all Official classes in both Jumping Equitation & Showjumping, except Seniors.

No Performance card = Ride HC

Cards to be handed in before the commencement of the event when checking in

DISPUTES: To be lodged with the organizing secretary accompanied with \$50 within 20 minutes of the class
