ENTRY: \$40 per horse (includes facility fee).

ENTRIES CLOSE: Tuesday 18th March*

**Numbers will be capped! Please nominate early to avoid disappointment.*

Riders may ride a maximum of two (2) horses as per Two Horse Rule (January 2018)

All events run under PCQ rules 2024 & all competitors must be a current 2025 riding member of PCQ or PCA

Prizes/Sashes to 1st Overall Placegetters, Ribbons to 4th in all classes (points to 10th)

Limited canteen facilities will be available on the day from 7am (Cash Only, No Eftpos)

One helper / penciller will be required for every 3 nominations or part thereof per club. Rider's club to ensure helping positions are filled.

No helpers = no ride.

DISCLAIMER: Neither the organising committee of any contest to which these rules apply, nor the PCQ, accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS: The Organisers reserve the right: to cancel any class or event; to combine classes if less than 3 competitors, or to divide any class according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting or groups, to alter the advertised times; to transfer competitors between sections of a class; to refuse any entry, with or without stating a reason.

PROTESTS: Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and should be accompanied by a \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

CLEANUP: The sportsgrounds are public-use grounds. All horse manure and left over hay MUST be collected and removed. We would greatly appreciate your help in bringing an empty feed bag and your own manure rake to take away your horse's manure and uneaten hay.

YARDS: Pre-booking of yards is essential. If your horse requires a yard, please contact Meghan Wehl (meg_schib@hotmail.com) for yard allocation (limited spaces). \$10 per yard which MUST BE CLEANED FREE OF MANURE AFTER USE.

REFUNDS: Will be made providing the organizing body is advised of the scratching before the commencement of the event and a written request including a vet or doctor's certificate is sent to the organizing committee within a week of the event. A 10% administration fee may be retained.
