ADDITIONAL NOTES:

If there are less than 3 riders in any class, they will be combined as per rules for combined groups. Combined groups: If one or two riders have been nominated for a class, then this group would be combined with the height above or below (one level only). For example, a 90cm class with 80cm or 1mtr.

Seniors can choose the height they wish to jump from Official or Unofficial Classes. They will jump with that group and place as if they are part of that group. However, their points are recorded separately so as not to take a place away from the Under 26 year old riders.

Riders may enter two horses as per PCQ 2025 Rules. Either one or two horses in the Official Section. Either one or two horses in the Unofficial Section.

DISPUTES:

All complaints should be made to: - Technical Delegate. The complaint will be adjudicated accordingly, and a Dispute Committee may be called if required. The complaint must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes and be accompanied by a fee of \$50.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS: -

The Organisers reserve the right

- (a) To cancel any class or event
- (b) To divide any class, or if less than 3 competitors combine classes
- (c) To alter the advertised times
- (d) To refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
- (e) To transfer competitors between sections of a class

In the event of horse movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance, and cost of their horse/horses.
