COMPETITION INFORMATION

RULES

Rules for this competition will be those published in the current PCQ Showjumping & Jumping Equitation Rulebooks.

LIABILITY

Neither the Organising Committee, nor PCQ, nor Wynnum Pony Club accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury, loss or illness to any horse, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS – The Organisers reserve the right to:

- a. To cancel any class or event
- b. (No longer applies)
- c. To alter the advertised times
- d. To refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
- e. To transfer competitors between sections of a class
- f. To combine classes if less than 3 competitors but will jump their own heights and are placed irrespective of the grade or the height jumped.
- g. *In the event of any inconsistency between the published program and the information contained on the Zone 1 Website, the information on the Zone 1 Website shall prevail.*

TWO HORSE RULE – Riders may enter 2 horses in the same or different heights. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards. For Jumping Equitation, the second horse must be in the same group to be competitive.

BIOSECURITY

We take biosecurity seriously and have measures in place to mitigate the risk of infections, diseases and pests. All horse owners and competitors should be aware that you have a biosecurity obligation to take all reasonable steps to ensure your activities do not spread a pest, disease or contaminant and to follow the instructions of the organising committee and the Biosecurity Manager or risk expulsion from the event.

PROTESTS – Must be in writing within 30 minutes of incident, accompanied by \$50. Only the owner, his authorised agent, or the rider of the horse taking part in the competition is entitled to lodge a protest. Disputes committee to consist of PCQ Technical Delegate, Chief Steward and One Judge.

WORKERS – SETUP – Clubs are reminded that this is a Zone event, and they must supply two willing workers for the working bee to be held on Saturday 5th June. Workers to nominate online. Failure to attend this working bee will result in the club riders competing HC.
