

- Prize for each Age Group for Best Dressed Rider & Horse Costume Combination for Jump Round

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### Further Information:

- This event run under PCQ January 2025 Showjumping Rule Book. Please be aware of the rules before competing.
- Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place. Prizes to overall winners and runner up of each age group or combined group.
- 2 Horse rule applies.
- Combined groups – Where insufficient nominations are received for a class or event, it will be run as per Combined Groups, as outlined in the PCQ January 2025 Showjumping Rule Book referred to, as above.
- Mobile Phones – Where mobile phones are required for personal medical usage, members are advised to apply for a Gear exemption so they can carry them while riding/competing. Outside of this, riders are not to carry a mobile phone on their person.
- Draw available on the day of competition.
- Performance Cards – are required for ALL riders in Classes 1-9 inclusive. Cards to be handed in to the Organising Secretary before the commencement of the event. THE CARD TO BE COMPLETED WITH THE FOLLOWING DETAILS BY THE RIDER: Date, Venue, Rider's name, Height, and the events: 0.0.0. Anywhere, N. Rider, 90cm AM7 AM6 Scurry
- Protests – Must be in writing within 30 minutes of the incident, accompanied by \$50-00. Only the owner, his/her authorised agent, or the rider of the horse competing are entitled to lodge a protest. Disputes committee will consist of PCQ Technical Delegate, and a representative from each Pony Club competing in the event/competition. Before lodging a protest, please remember that all event officials operate in a volunteer capacity, experience levels vary, the event is run for you and your horse's benefit and the PCQ Code of Behaviour operates for this event.

- Classes 3 and 4 will be one round – Table A ideal time.
- Classes 5-9 will jump an AM7 (238 – 2.4) jump off fastest time.
- All riders must wear long-sleeve, sun-safe shirts, and respectable riding wear.
- All riders must comply with PCA National Gear Rules.
- Riders must jump with their age group (no HC riders unless otherwise decided by the judges on the day).
- Ribbons and points to 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each event (no points for classes 1 and 2 and participation ribbons provided. These events will not be timed.) Points are: 1<sup>st</sup> = 3; 2<sup>nd</sup> = 2; 3<sup>rd</sup> = 1.
- Prizes to overall winner of each age group (excluding Class 1 and 2). Class 1 and Class 2 – Gift bag for each rider.
- Mobile Phones – While mounted, riders are not to carry a mobile phone on their person, unless with a PCQ Exemption Form.
- Protests – Must be in writing within 30 minutes of the incident, accompanied by \$50-00. Only the owner, his/her authorised agent, or the rider of the horse competing are entitled to lodge a protest.
