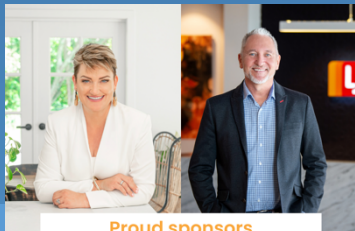

CONDITIONS:

Two Horse Rule: A competitor may ride two horses in the same or different heights/classes. Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards.

10 years & under: May choose to ride in either 10 & under OR 12 & under.

Seniors: To be eligible for Overall Senior Award, Seniors choose from official classes.

The second Dressage test will act as the CT test as well.

If riding in both D and CT the same graded level is required- Eg Novice dressage and novice CT etc.

Biosecurity guidelines.

Lunging: Lunging is only to be done in the round yard behind the clubhouse.

When entering via Twohill Lane please close the gate.

Formal Pony Club uniform is required

Combined Groups: Where insufficient entries are received in a particular class, it will be run as per rules for Combined Groups. (See rule book)

Performance cards are required for All riders in official classes, except Seniors. It's the rider's responsibility to complete the classes nominated for the day. Performance card & horse health declaration form to be handed in when numbers collected.

Bridle numbers can be worn.
