OTT Awards:

Best Performed OTT for each class - Rosette

Best Performed OTT (High Point) on the day - Saddle blanket & sash

Best Performed OTT (High Point) for combined Showjumping and Gymkhana (must compete in both events) - Trophy Rug

OTT Participation Criteria: Must be the same horse-rider combination for the duration of the event; when nominating, must provide horse's racing name, whether they are standardbred or thoroughbred, microchip number & consent to photo use for QOTT marketing purposes.

PROTESTS: Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and should be accompanied by a \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld

ATTIRE: Pony Club members must wear formal uniform (Class 1 & 2 may wear rally shirts if they choose). Non-Pony Club members must wear long sleeve, sun-safe shirts and respectable riding wear, boots, and **helmets**.

GENERAL:

- This event is run under current PCQ rules and gear must comply with PCA National Gear Rule Book.
- Points are: First = 5, Second = 4, Third = 3, Fourth = 2, Fifth = 1
- Riders must jump with their age group (no-HC riders unless decided otherwise by the judge)
- First Aid will be in attendance for the duration of the competition
- Biosecurity Statement and PCQ Code of Behaviour are located on the notice board in the canteen area
- Non-Pony Club Riders must complete a waiver which can be accessed here <u>Day-Participant-Event-Waiver-and-Liability-Declaration-Pony-Club-Australia-New.pdf</u> (ponyclubqld.com.au) or as a link when nominating.

CAMPING & STABLES: must be booked and paid through <u>nominate.com</u> MUST be left clean and tidy and free of manure and rubbish.

- Powered Camping \$20 per night
- Unpowered \$10 per night
- Manure MUST be dumped in dump points.
- Stables no bookings available. Stables MUST be left clean and tidy and free of manure and rubbish
- Dogs are permitted but MUST always be on lead and not allowed in the canteen area

HORSE HEALTH DECLARATIONS: You will need to download the Nominate app on your phone. Horse health declarations will be completed when nominating and finalised when you check in via the QR code and Nominate app on arrival. Instructions provided in attachment on Nominate. Alternatively, you can provide a printed copy to the announcer's box on arrival.

MOBILE PHONES: not to be used while on horseback. In a competition, an athlete breaching this rule may be eliminated.
