- **TWO HORSE RULE:** Riders may enter 2 horses in the same age group only. When competing in Rider Class, Pony Club Hack riders must follow the direction of the judge. The 2nd horse must be held by an unmounted competent person wearing appropriate footwear.
- The mount should be the members normal pony club mount and regularly ridden at Pony Club.
- The judges and stewards' decision are final.
- The committee reserves the right to alter the program in any way that may be deemed necessary.

Reservation of Rights

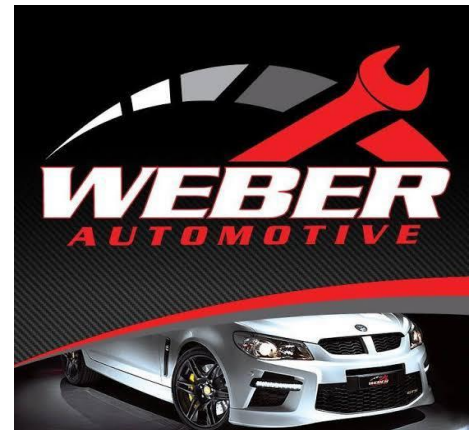

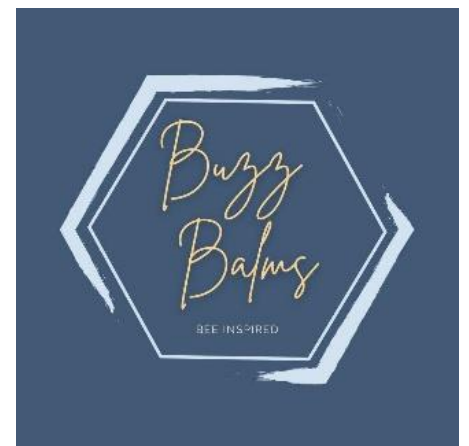
