Performance Cards: This event is a State Championship qualifier for 2026 and run under current PCQ competition rules and PCA national gear rules. Performance cards are required for Classes 1–9 and must be filled out with the following details by the rider: Date, Venue, Rider's name, Height, and the events before handing to the event secretary prior to the event commencement - NO CARDS – NO AWARDS. If you have not received your card prior to event then you must contact PCQ and provide your number to organising club prior to event commencement.

AWARDS

Official classes: Ribbons to 5th place, Broad sash and prize for the overall champion and runner up of each Official class.

Unofficial Classes: Ribbons to 5th place, Broad sash to 2nd place overall.

The event will be run under PCQ rules including **Two horse rule:** Riders may enter 2 horses in the same or different heights within age group. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.

Protests: Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and should be accompanied by a \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

General: First aid will be in attendance; Riders currently competing in Official 12 and Under or Official 13 & Under 26 classes cannot ride an Official 12 and under or Official 13 & Under 26 horse in an unofficial section; Horse/athlete combination can move between heights but not on the same day; Horse/rider combination can qualify for a number of height classes for State Championships, but compete at State at the highest height that horse/rider combination has qualified.

Catering: The Canteen will be available for light refreshments

Camping & Day yards:

- Camping \$10 for weekend paid with your nominations.
- No camping within 10mtr of the Working Horse club arenas or shed (who share our grounds). This includes any attachments. These arenas are out of bounds to ALL competitors.
- No attachments of any kind to the boundary mesh fence this includes, Hay bags, horses, fencing, awnings, dogs etc
- ALL Rubbish must be taken with you. We do not have a curb side rubbish collection.
- Manure/hay MUST be dumped in the designated areas. Not under the trees. Wheel barrows and rakes are provided.
- Day yards MUST be left clean and tidy. Free of manure, hay and rubbish, chains rehung and gates closed please. No electric fencing.
- Dogs are permitted, but must be secured at your camp during competition. They MUST be on lead at all times. Dogs are not allowed in the canteen area, horse arena's, day yards or toilet areas. Pick up their mess.

HHD & WAIVER: Completed Waiver and horse health declarations incl PIC# to be handed to the secretary on arrival, prior to start of competition. No HHD, No waiver = no ride.

MOBILE PHONES: Not to be used while on horseback. In a competition, any rider breaching this rule may be eliminated. Exemption for riders who have a Rider exemption card for medical purposes, and notified organisers when nominating.

DISCLAIMER: Neither the organising committee of this event or any contest to which these rules apply, nor PCQ accepts any liability for the damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever. Competitors ride at their own risk under rules of PCQ.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS: The organising committee reserves the right to; cancel any class or event; to divide any class; to alter the advertised times; to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason, to transfer competitors between sections of a class and to combine classes if less than 3 competitors.
