2. Mobile phones not to be used on horseback and will incur elimination from the day.
3. For Pony Clubs affiliated with PCQ and all events according to PCA National Gear Rules 2025
4. Competitors leaving their group without permission of the steward or riding in a dangerous manner anywhere on the ground will be disqualified for the day.
5. No outside assistance to be given.
6. One senior member from each club will form the disputes committee and its decision will be final. A fee of \$50.00 is to be lodged with the protest within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the event.
7. Judge's decision is final.
8. Member to adhere to dress code and Helmets as per latest ruling.
9. Dogs Allowed on leash at camp
10. Riders must be present to accept the award otherwise it will be forfeited. No awards will be handed out prior to presentation. Organizers, at their discretion have the right to waive this requirement.
11. Stables & camping areas must be left free of rubbish and manure.
12. ONLY COMPETITORS AND OFFICIALS TO BE IN COMPETITION ARENA.
13. Reservation of Rights; The Organisers reserve the right: a) to cancel any class or event, b) to divide any class, c) to alter the advertised times, d) to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason, e) to transfer competitors between sections of a class, f) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors.
