COMPETITION RULES

- 1. All participants must comply with equipment and dress rules of Pony Club, specifically with regard to saddlery, helmet, boots, spurs and equipment.
- 2. Helmets: Must meet PCAQ rules as per their website.
- 3. All saddles must have 2 fastenings to the girth or if only one girth fastening a surcingle as well.
- 4. Rowel spurs allowed in sporting events only. Not to be used for jumping.
- 5. Split reins are permitted but must be joined by a buckle, knot or securely taped so as to not allow movement at join of reins or any likelihood of reins coming undone or apart during competition. To shorten split reins they may be doubled up at the ends provided they are securely taped all the way to the end.
- 6. Riders to ride in their own age group only.
- 7. Riders will only be given three calls to present to the judge for their event, otherwise will be eliminated.
- 8. All events will start on time.
- 9. Mobile phones are not to be used while on horseback.

Neither the organising committee of any contest to which these rules apply, nor the PCAQ, accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

The Organisers reserve the right:
