

**PROTESTS:** To be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and accompanied by a \$50.00 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

#### Mobile Phones:

Riders are not to carry on their person any mobile phone whilst mounted.

Each club is to nominate a delegate at start of competition to form disputes committee.

Horse and Participant Health Declarations must be handed in on the day.

First Aid will be in attendance.

From 1st January 2018, the competitive horse rule currently exists for Show Jumping will be applied to ODE, Dressage and Combined Training at the discrection of the organizing committee riders may enter 2 horses in the following way: Riders may enter 2 horses in the same or different heights. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be placed and is eligible for overall awards.

Riders cannot choose to upgrade or downgrade on the day of the competition. This must be applied for and approved prior to the competition.

Dogs must be kept on a lead.

DOGS ARE TO BE RESTRAINED AT ALL TIMES AND MUST REMAIN AT YOUR CAMP/FLOAT.
