(12 years & under)

Instruction	Score /10
Present to Judge, Salute. walk down centreline to A Long rein	
At A , working trot, At B trot circle to the Right 20m, showing balance, rhythm and even circle	
At B canter Left 20 m using Both hands	
At B, Canter right, using Both hands Bend through pegs, leaving first peg on right. Maintain the canter and lead changes.	
After pegs, continue at Canter to C, showing control of pony and rider's position.	
At C, Downward transition through paces Halt at B.	
Reign back 4 paces, halt.	
Walk forward on Loose rein to \boldsymbol{M} and Halt.	
At M Dismount, (13 and over will do rein drill) Lead pony to A.	
At A present yourself and pony to the Judge, wait for acknowledgement, return to troop

All Round Pony Club Mount (13 and over)

Instruction	Score /10
Present to Judge, Salute. walk down centreline to A Long rein	
At A , working trot, At B trot circle to the Right 20m, showing balance, rhythm and even circle At B canter Left 20 m	
Reins in one hand	
At B, Canter right, using Both hands, bend through pegs, leaving first peg on the right. Maintain the canter and lead changes.	
After pegs, hand Gallop Around to C, Showing control of pony and rider's position.	
At C, Downward transition through paces Halt at B.	
Rein back 4 paces, halt.	
Walk forward on Loose rein to M and halt.	
At M dismount, (13 and over will do rein drill), Lead pony to A.	
At A, present yourself and pony to the Judge, wait for acknowledgment, return to troop line.

RULES:

- 1. Compulsory Gear Check for all riders at the start of the day.
- 2. No Smoking on pony club grounds
- 3. First Aid in attendance Event Run Under minimum medical standards for pony club®
- 4. No rider is to have their phone on them while mounted. If you are seen with your phone on you while mounted, you will be eliminated for the day.
- 5. Late nomination fee of \$5.00 per rider if accepted by organizing committee.
- 6. All events will be run in accordance with PCQ Sporting Rules 2025 and PCA National Gear Rules
- 7. No additions or deletion or leaving the arena between Presentation & Rider Class.
- 8. All Riders MUST participate in the Mounted presentation at the completion of both days
- 9. Riders must not leave the grounds until after the presentation unless permission is given from the CHIEF STEWARD
- 10. Competitors may be asked to produce proof of 2025 PCQ or PCA Membership.
- 11. Horses must always be ridden at a walk when not competing. This includes the car park areas.
- 12. DISPUTES: All complaints should be made to the Chief Steward. The disputes committee will adjudicate accordingly. The complaint must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes & be accompanied by a fee of \$50.
- 13. By nominating for this Event competitors agree to allow Met. Zone 1 to use any photos taken of them at the Event for promotional purposes on their web.
- 14. One Club Representative collects Riders numbers and hand in Horse Health declarations.
- 15. Riding pairs of riders will be held at the completion of the day and is part of the competition. Points will not count to the rider's individual scores, but riders will be judged and placed accordingly and awarded with ribbons. Riders must ride with another rider from the same club firstly, but if this can't be achieved, riders can ride with another rider from another club forming a composite team.
