**YARDS ARE AVAILABLE** — To be pre-booked on nomination with your entry. If you require one on the day, please see the office before putting your horse in one, and it must be paid for on the day. You will also need to have \$25 cash in an envelope for a bond, which will be returned at the end of the day when cleaned. All yards and stables attract a bond and are refundable after the event via nominate. Preference of stables, yards and camping will be given to those staying for the whole event.

## Conditions of Entry - Burpengary Pony Club Jumping Equitation and Combined Training

- BIOSECURITY POLICY: All horse owners and competitors should be aware that they have a
  biosecurity obligation to take all reasonable steps to ensure their activities do not spread a pest,
  disease, or contaminant. Competitors are required to ensure good biosecurity practices at home
  and at the event and to follow the instructions of the organising committee and the Biosecurity
  Manager, or risk expulsion from the event.
- OUR BIOSECURITY PLAN: Our event biosecurity plan is a set of preventative control measures
  and actions aimed at reducing the risk of infectious diseases and pests on and off the venue,
  and between horses at the venue. This can be found at our event office.
- DISCLAIMER: Neither the organising committee of any contest to which these rules apply, nor
  the PCQ accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners,
  athletes, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. This Disclosure must
  be printed on all programmes.
- RESERVATION OF RIGHTS The Organisers reserve the right to cancel any class of event, to divide any class, to alter the advertised times, to refuse entry with or without stating a reason, to transfer competitors between sections of a class, to combine classes if less than three competitors. Biosecurity as per current regulations. COVID-19 regulations as per QLD Health Guidelines.
- Refunds –Before close of entries you can withdraw on nominate or edit your entry. There will be
  no refund of entry fees for withdrawals after close of entries unless a written request with Vet or
  Doctor certificate included within 7 days of request and a 20% administration fee will be
  deducted. In the event of COVID restrictions or an extreme weather event there will be a 20%
  administration fee withheld if the event is cancelled.
- Objections, Appeals and disputes must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$50 and handed to the Event Secretary no later than 30 minutes after the instance which gave rise to the objection.
- Completed Horse Health Declaration to be handed in to the office when collecting Back Numbers. Run under PCQ Rules and PCA Gear Rules open to PCQ Members only. As a condition of entry, each rider <u>MUST</u> provide a helper. This event will follow the No Help, No Ride policy!
- Competitors must compete in full pony club uniform and be in uniform to collect awards.
   Presentation is at the end of the day; all competitors are expected to be in attendance for presentation unless prior permission to leave has been granted. Lack of attendance at the presentation without permission to leave will result in forfeiture of the competitor's prizes.

- Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards.
- Combined Groups: Where insufficient entries are received in a particular class, it will be run as per the rules for combined groups in the rule book. Riders may enter a second competitive horse, but if in the same section, you need to consider that ride times will be close.
- Riders in official classes (1-10) must produce performance cards to the office prior to 8am on
  the day of competition unless other arrangements have been made with the organising
  committee. If the rider does not have a performance card on the day of competition, ribbons
  and trophies are withheld until it is produced. Nominations that do not have Horse Registration
  number and riders who do not have a performance card on the day, will compete HC.
