RULES AND CONDITIONS:

1. Event to be run in accordance with PCA Gear check rules.
2. First Aid will be in attendance in accordance with PCA Minimum Medical Standards.
3. The Judge's decision is final in all events.
4. Disputes are to be lodged within 30 minutes of the completion of any event and must be accompanied by a \$50 fee.
5. The committee reserves the right to amend the program.
6. All competitors must wear an approved helmet & be suitably attired in Pony Club uniform.

Two horse rule: Equitation - A competitor may ride two horses in the same or different heights. Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards.

Showjumping - A competitor may ride two horses in the same or different heights. Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards.

Combined groups: Where insufficient entries are received in a particular class, it will be run as per rules for Combined Groups in the rule book.

Performance Cards: Are required for ALL RIDERS in Official classes 1-7 and 11-19 inclusive. Cards are to be presented to the organising committee before the commencement of the event.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS:
