

PCQ Zone Teams Showjumping Challenge 2025



Hosted by Zone 6 Pony Clubs at Nambour Showgrounds

Fri 17th, Sat 18th and Sun 19th October 2025

Zone 6 Pony Clubs, together with Zone 26, are excited to invite Teams to compete in this event, to be held at the Nambour Showgrounds.

Riders from all Zones are welcome to join in this fun and supportive event that shows off what Pony Club spirit is all about!

Zones must put forward their teams to compete. Individuals need to comply with whatever process your zone has in place to join a team. Zones will forward the Team lists to us on a spreadsheet that will be sent directly to them. All fees and nominations are to be completed and paid by each competitor via Nominate. You then need to contact your Zone to let them know you have nominated and would like to be in a team. You can only be in 1 team.

Camping and Stabling are booked via Nominate. Stable bonds will be refunded within a reasonable amount of time after the event – as long as your stable has been left clean and tidy.

Online Nominations open late August and will close Wednesday 1st October 2025.

If Zones have riders keen to compete but can't put together a full team it is possible for composite teams to be put together. Teams of 3 riders may take part. Each Zone may enter any number of teams in each age group, but only 1 team per rider.

Seniors are permitted to enter in the 13 & over classes. HOWEVER, teams must **NOT** contain more than 2 senior riders.

Origin, Puissance: \$10 entry fee

Teams: We will require zones to provide their teams by Sunday 5th October 2024

Canteen: Canteen and coffee van will be available from Friday

Helpers: All competitors are required to provide a helper to assist over the event. We will

be using "sign up" to fill the required helper jobs. These will include pencilling, gear check (preferably qualified), gate steward, rail steward etc. Please select a

job or one will be allocated to you.

Horse Health Dec: To be handed in on arrival for every horse entering the grounds –

If not completed on Nominate. (Please ensure a PIC number is provided from the

horses property of origin)

Trot Up; All horses competing in the Teams events must be trotted out to check for

lameness. This can be done Friday afternoon or Saturday morning. Each Zone is to present as a group. Trot Up will be unmounted. Horses are to wear bridles, no boots. Riders are to wear full riding gear (including helmets), with their zone t-

shirt (or as determined by your Zone). Time to be confirmed.

Merchandise: A range of clothing and memorabilia will be available for online purchase via

Nominate. Orders will close quite early to ensure we have the merchandise arrive in time for the event. Further details to be provided when known.

Uniforms; For the Origin events, riders are to wear full zone uniform with their Zone polo t-

shirt. For the Teams events, riders are to wear full formal zone uniform. (In

composite teams, you are still required to wear the uniform from your own zone)

TEAM MANAGERS

Each Zone should appoint an Overall Team Manager who is responsible for all members of his/her zone at all times.

In addition, Zones should appoint a Manager for each team attending, who will be responsible for his/her team at all times.

Only Zone Team Managers may walk the courses with their team.

Overall Zone Team Managers to advise before the start of competition any substitution of riders or horses in their teams.

Any approach to organisers for any reason whatsoever must be made through the Overall Team Manager.

Protests must be lodged through the Overall Team Manager within 30 minutes of results being displayed. Fee of \$50 is only refundable if the protest is upheld.

Overall Team Manager from each Zone to be responsible for collection and return of back numbers.

A Team Managers meeting will be held on Friday afternoon at the Scout Hall Office.

Please bring Zone banners for mounted presentation.

No electric fences allowed

Dogs must be on a lead at all times and kept in the camping area. No dogs are allowed around the stables or competition areas.

First Aid will be in attendance throughout

Event will be run under current PCQ Showjumping Rules and current PCA National Gear Rules.

Biosecurity Plan will be in place. Vet and Farrier will also be on call. Details to be provided. PLEASE DO NOT BRING ANY SICK HORSES ONTO THE GROUNDS.

Riders who have booked stables will be allocated a stable for the duration of the event. No riders or horses are to switch stables without prior approval from the organising committee.
