RULES AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. Competitors ride at their own risk, and under the rules of PCAQ and 2025 PCA current Gear and Saddlery Rules.
- 2. The Judge's decision is final in ALL events.
- 3. Disputes are to be lodged within 30 minutes of the completion of any event and must be accompanied by a \$50.00 fee.
- 4. All competitors must wear an approved helmet and be suitably attired in Pony Club Uniform.
- 5. "If rider does not have performance card on the day of competition, ribbons and trophies are withheld until it is produced.

 Nominations that do not have Horse Registration Number AND riders do not have performance card on the day; riders will compete HC"
- **6.** Riders may enter 2 horses in same or different heights/class. Each horse may gain qualifying results, each horse will be placed in it's class and eligible for overall awards.
- 7. Seniors To be eligible for overall awards, Seniors choose from Class 4-7 inclusive.

The Organisers reserve the right:

- a) To cancel any class or event
- b) To divide any class not applicable for Showjumping
- c) To alter the advertised times
- d) To refuse entry, with or without stating the reason
- e) To transfer competitors between sections of a class
- f) To combine classes if less than 3 competitors

All parents will be required to help.

Rider's club to ensure helping positions are filled. No helpers = No ride.
