Uniforms

1. BIBS: Bibs provided, Zone Manager responsible for return, lost bibs will be charged (\$55 each).
2. Riding Phase Uniform: **Official Zone uniform to be worn.**
Shooting Phase: Formal Zone uniform or Zone Polo shirt; Footwear is enclosed shoes that do not cover the anklebone – no riding boots. Running Shoes Preferred
3. Swimming Phase: Swimsuits to be 1 piece – no bikinis.
4. Running Phase: Preferably the zone polo or a running shirt in your zone colours.
5. For specific phase requirements details see rules.

Optimum Time / QLD Rule Modifications

6. Refer to Tetrathlon Rulebook for official optimum times for running.
7. Shooting Phase as per rule book

Jumping Phase

8. Riders can choose which maximum height they can do. If a height lower than the maximum height is chosen riders **cannot gain maximum points**. The points per height per age group are outlined below.
9. Max Points available 1400 - Riders may select a lower jumping height, this will result in a lower available max point. Penalties are as per the PCA 2024 tetrathlon rulebook. It will be a showjumping derby course and anything not covered in the PCA Tetrathlon rulebook, for example Disobediences, will be as per the PCQ Showjumping rulebook.
10. Riders must wear a Body protector per the PCA 2025 Rule book [PCA Gear Rule Book 2025](#)
11. Mini riders may ride a shorter course. The gate will be left open for all mini competitors.

Swimming Phase – Swim to Time

12. Competitors will be required to swim for a set length of distance per the rule book. Competitors will start on or off the blocks together. A whistle or similar will indicate the start of the race. All competitors will swim the distance and the time will be recorded

In all classes, participants will swim the distance according to their age.

Rules and Information

13. **HOT OR WET WEATHER CONTINGENCY:** In the event of extreme heat or wet weather, we will try to proceed with the event if possible; but reserve the right to move/reschedule the start times to earlier on Saturday the 25th of October 2025.
The Official class riding phase will include a mixture of show jumps, a gate, and a sliprail.
14. **RULES:** As per the PCA (Pony Club Australia) 2024 National Tetrathlon rules with a few scoring modifications to create the QLD official classes. Please read the 2024 Tetrathlon Rulebook. [PCA-Combined-PCQ-rules-2024-1.pdf](#) Please note the changes in red.
15. **ZONE TEAM MANAGER:** Each Zone will appoint a Team Manager and notify the organizing committee of their name and contact details as soon as they have been appointed. Any protests must come through the Team Manager
16. **BANNERS:** Zones are requested to bring their banners.
17. **PRESENTATION:** It is the Team Manager's responsibility to assemble all competitors for the presentation. All riders are required to stay for the presentation, mounted (TBC) and in full uniform, ribbon winners or not for the final parade. Request for special permission to leave MUST be made in writing by the Zone Team Manager and may be granted by the Judge in Chief/Chief Steward in exceptional circumstances.
18. **DRAW:** The final copy of the draw will be displayed at the secretary's office and emailed out. 1 horse 1 rider – 1 rider 1 horse for Tetrathlon
19. **RIDER'S AGE:** Age is as at 1 Jan 2025 (per PCA rules).
20. **PHONES:** No rider is to have their phone whilst mounted, riders using phones whilst mounted will be eliminated for the day.
21. **COVID:** All COVID requirements must be followed by all competitors and spectators while on the grounds.



22. **YARD BOND:** \$20, charged via Nominate. Yards must be left clean of manure and Hay etc in order to recover the stable bond. Refund will be processed via Nominate.
23. **YARDS:** Large, secure but not undercover
24. **TRANSPORT TO SWIMMING POOL:** Horses cannot be left at floats without vehicles attached.
25. **HHD:** Horse Health Declarations to be handed in prior to the start of the event.
26. **REFUNDS:** Refunds will be made providing the organizing body is advised of the scratching before the commencement of the event and a written request including a vet or doctor's certificate is sent to the organizing committee within a week of the event: A 25% administration fee may be retained.
27. **HELPERS: One event helper per family is mandatory.** By nominating you are also agreeing to help with an appropriate event role assigned by the committee, if helpers miss their allocated role and do not find a replacement the associated competitor will ride HC.
28. **DOGS:** Dogs allowed in camping area only. Must be on a leash at ALL times. (please pick up after your dog)
29. **CANTEEN:** Full canteen available for Saturday lunch, dinner, Sunday breakfast and lunch with snacks and drinks. Coffee Van in attendance
30. **GEAR CHECK:** Whilst an official gear check will be carried out, the safety of rider's gear is ultimately the responsibility of the competitor and their parent / guardian.
31. **STOCK INSPECTORS:** The event is run in a tick free area, please ensure all requirements are met prior to arriving, thank you.
32. **SWABBING:** There may be random swabbing at this event.
33. **ORDER OF START:** Competitors must ride/compete in the order of the draw. A provisional draw and phase schedule will be emailed. Riders must be prepared to ride earlier if there are scratchings. Start times will be announced over the PA on the day of competition.
34. **AGE OF HORSE:** Horse must be a minimum age of 4 years.
35. **EXERCISE:** Competitors may only exercise their horses in the designated areas on the event map which will be provided. Horses may be schooled or exercised only by the nominated rider on the day of the competition. Horses may be lunged by the nominated rider, a parent or club instructor, in the designated area. Riders disregarding these rules could incur disqualification from the event. Competitors must not ride on or near any part of the courses prior to the competition. Horses must be correctly saddled, and the competitor must wear a helmet, riding boots and competition number whilst exercising their horse.
36. **STATE/ZONE TEAMS:** Riders in official classes will be included in the State and Zone official Teams.



Disputes

37. **All complaints must be made through the Zone Manager to the:** Technical Delegate. The complaint will be adjudicated accordingly, and a Dispute Committee may be called if required.
The complaint must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes and be accompanied by a fee of \$100.

Biosecurity and Risk Assessment Plans

38. In the event of horse movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance, and cost of their horse/horses. Including and not limited to feeding and watering and vet cost for the time of the restriction. An up-to-date BIOSECURITY PLAN and RISK ASSESSMENT PLAN will be available at the Club House.

Reservation of Rights

The Organisers reserve the right

- (a) To cancel any class or event
- (b) To divide any class, or if less than 3 competitors combine classes
- (c) To alter the advertised times and schedule
- (d) To refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
- (e) To transfer competitors between sections of a class
