RULES



- A team consists of 3 riders. Example: club, zone or mixed All scores to count.
- Saturday- Riders can wear either club or zone uniform.
- Sunday- Riders can ride in free dress. Attire must still meet approved PCA gear requirements
- Entries from mixed club or zone teams must come through a club secretary.
- Any outstanding payment must be made prior to the commencement of competition.
- Saturday, a rider can be in a second team on the same or different horse in the same age group.
- On Sunday a rider can be in second team on the same or different horse in the same grade or the level above or below if on the same horse. Eg. Sally is riding Sam in prelim level in a team and may ride on a second team but only at prelim or novice level not elementary.
- If a horse and rider are competing in the prep competition Sunday, they aren't eligible to compete in an aged team event Saturday on that same horse.
- All classes on Sunday are open age group team.
- Points are awarded on a descending scale from 10 to 1 for each test in each ring.
i.e. 10 points for 1st, 9 points for 2nd, etc.
- In the event of a tie in individual tests the average of the points available for these placings is allotted to each horse, e.g. =2nd, points 9 (for 2nd) and 8 (for 3rd) = 17, averaged = 8.5 points for each horse.
- Add individual points for placings in each ring to obtain the total for the team for that test. This is repeated for the second test.
- In the event of a tie for a team in an individual test the percentages will be added together to determine the placings.
- The Champion Team is the team with the most points, e.g. In test 1 the scores added up to 21 points, in test 2 the scores are added up to 15 points giving that team a total of 36 points.
- In the event of a tie for the Champion Team Eg: 2 teams on 55 points, the percentages from the three riders in all tests will be added together. The team with the highest overall percentage will be the winning team.
 - If you are unable to make a team please express an interest via email as composite teams may be formed by the organising committee.
 - A horse can be ridden by one member of a club on one day of competition and another member from the same club on the other day of competition.
- **Mixed Teams Competition- Sunday- A team comprising of 3 members. A team must cover two levels.** Eg- 2 preliminary team riders and 1 novice rider make up the team or 1 elementary rider and 2 prep riders or 1 prep, 1 prelim and 1 novice rider.
- **A minimum number of three competitors must be in a level for team points to be given.**
