# EVENT INFORMATION AND COMPETITION RULES

## ALL EVENTS RUN AS PER CURRENT (as of 31<sup>st</sup> January 2026) PCAQ SHOW JUMPING & PCA GEAR AND SADDLERY RULES

### CONDITIONS:

**Two Horse Rule** - As per SJ & JE Rule Book: A competitor may ride two horses in the same or different heights. Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards.

**Seniors:** To be eligible for the Overall Senior Award, Seniors choose from Class 4 (70cm) or above. If not height is nominated you will be placed in class 4 (70cm).

**Combined Groups:** Where insufficient entries are received in a particular class, it will be run as per rules for Combined Groups in rule book.

### Refunds & Scratching:

**Scratching Prior to event entry close:** via nominate, full refund.

**Scratching after close of event entries:** No refund given except on presentation of a Veterinary or Doctor Certificate. Must be done via email: nambourponyclub01@gmail.com

**First Aid:** First Aid will be in attendance in accordance with PCA Minimal First Aid Standards.

**Performance cards:** Are required for all Official riders. Cards are to be completed with details of each class and presented to the Organising Secretary before the commencement of the event when collecting back numbers.

**Falls:** In the event of a fall, the rider must present to the First Aid Officer before continuing to ride.

**Behavior:** As per PCQ Rules. No mobile phones while mounted, bad language/behavior towards officials or other competitors will not be tolerated and may lead to elimination.

**Reservation of Rights:** The Organising Committee reserves the right to:

- a. To cancel any class or event
- b. To divide any class (not applicable for Showjumping)
- c. To alter advertised times
- d. To refuse any entry with or without stating a reason.
- e. To transfer competitors between sections of a class
- f. To combine classes if less than 3 competitors and the rules governing combining groups

**DISPUTES:** are to be lodged to the Organising secretary accompanied with \$50.00 within 20minutes of the event.
