**Two horse rule apply** (applies to Showjumping), a competitor may ride two horses in the same or different heights. Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and also for Overall awards.

**Stewards:** All Clubs are asked to help on the day of the competition. To ensure the smooth running of the Competition, we will be asking for helpers to help adjust the courses and pick up rails during the event. We may also need to call for pencillers.

**Protests:** Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and accompanied by a \$50.00 fee which is refundable only if protest is upheld.

**PCQ rules** Apply to all events. All events will be conducted under 2026 Showjumping Rules

**Canteen:** All facilities available on the day.
