RULES & CONDITIONS



RULES

1. to be judged under current PCQ Rules for Showjumping & Jumping Equitation and PCA National Gear Rules
2. All competitors must be a current riding member of PCQ or PCA
3. competitors ride at their own risk under the rules of PCQ
4. all riders must provide a helper for the event
5. the judges decision is final in all events
6. disputes are to be lodged within 30 minutes of the completion of any event and must be accompanied by a \$50 fee
7. all competitors must wear an approved helmet and be suitably attired in pony club uniform
8. riders must be financial members of an affiliated Pony Club on day of competition

CONDITIONS

Two Horse Rule Showjumping a competitor may ride **two horses in the same or different heights**.

Each horse may gain qualifying results, is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards.

Two horse Rule Equitation Athletes may enter **two horses in the same or different class**. Each horse may gain qualifying results.

Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.

Seniors to be eligible for Overall Senior Award, Seniors choose from Class 4-9 inclusive

Combined Groups where insufficient entries are received in a particular class, it will be run as per rules for Combined Groups in rule book.

Pre-filled Performance Cards are required for all riders in class 1-9 Showjumping & 1-7 Equitation.

Cards to be presented to the Organising Secretary before commencement of event. completed with details of each class.

Performance Cards required for both Jumping Equitation and Showjumping as at 1.2.24

Reservation of rights the organising committee reserves the right

1. To cancel any class or event
2. To divide class (not applicable to Show Jumping)
3. To alter advertised times
4. To refuse any entry with or without stating reason
5. To transfer competitors between sections of a class

To combine classes if less than 3 competitors and the rules governing combining groups.

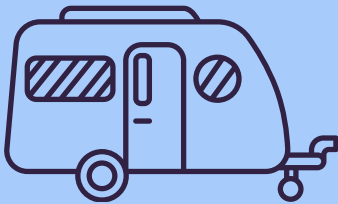
Housekeeping

CAMPING



- \$30/night to be paid at time of nomination
- fee applies to members and non-members
- campsites must be clean prior to departure
- power leads must not be run across roads or horse thoroughfares
- please let event organisers know if showers need attention
- horses are not permitted in camping area during events



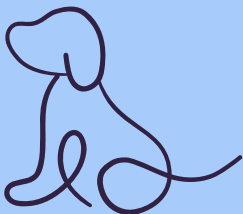
STABLES/YARDS

- \$5 per horse/night to be paid at time of nomination
- no charge for YHPC Members
- must be cleared of all manure prior to departure
- \$20 deposit required with nomination & returned after event



SCOOTERS & BIKES

- permitted on road areas and camping area only
- **not permitted** near stables, horses and competition areas
- riders must wear a helmet at all times



DOGS

- well behaved dogs permitted under supervision
- **not permitted** near stables, horses or competition arenas
- dogs must remain on lead at all times - refer PCAQ By-Laws
