COMPETITION INFORMATION

- **RULES – PCQ & PCA Rules apply to this Event:**

Rules for this competition will be published in the current PCQ General Rules, Showjumping, & Jumping Equitation Rulebooks and PCA National Gear Rules.

- **RESERVATION OF RIGHTS**

The organising committee reserves the right to; cancel any class or event, combine (Jumping their own heights and placed irrespective of their height jumped); or divide classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups, alter advertised times, transfer competitors between sections of a class; and refuse any entry with, or without stating a reason.

- **DISCLAIMER:**

Neither the organising committee of this event, Moggill Pony Club, nor PCQ accepts any liability for the damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever. **The final responsibility for the suitability of the mount, saddlery and equipment rests with the Rider or their responsible adult. (see General Rules)**

- **PROTESTS:**

Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident, and should be accompanied by \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld. [Disputes Committee to consist of Event TD plus One senior official from each club; nominee to be lodged with entries. The committee's decision will be final.](#)

- **TWO HORSE RULE:**

Riders may enter 2 horses in the same, or different heights. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards. For Jumping Equitation, the second horse must be in the same group to be competitive

- **BIOSECURITY**

We take biosecurity seriously and have measures in place to mitigate the risk of infections, diseases and pests. All horse owners and competitors should be aware that you have a biosecurity obligation to take all reasonable steps to ensure your activities do not spread any pests, disease or contaminant and to follow the instructions of the organising committee and the Biosecurity Manager or risk expulsion from the event.
