



All classes/competition to run as per current (as of 31st January 2026) PCAQ Show Jumping, Jumping Equitation & PCA Gear & Saddlery Rules.

First Aid: Will be in attendance as per PCA minimum Medical Requirements

Bridle number to be used on both Jumping Equitation & Showjumping events.

Riders may enter 2 horses in either the same or different classes

Each horse will be placed in its class & eligible for overall awards.

All current Covid & Bio Security requirements will be met at the time of the event.

NO DOGS permitted on Grounds.

PERFORMANCE CARDS: Required for all Official classes in both Jumping Equitation & Showjumping, except for Seniors.

NO PERFORMANCE CARD = RIDE HC

Cards to be handed in before the commencement of the event with Horse Health
