Rules & Regulations

Horses will compete in two tests on the day – relevant dressage test will be used for CT dressage phase.

By nominating you are also agreeing to help or your entry will be amended to HC.

Performance Cards: ALL Official Competitors are to hand in pre-filled performance cards before competition begins.

Numbers: provided by rider; bridle or saddlecloth preferred.

Camping/Stabling: please book with entry; \$35 per night per stable; \$35 per night per campsite

Prizes: Ribbons to 5th place for individual tests & CT. Champion & Reserve rosettes/prizes for each class.

Refunds: Scratching before draw - full refund; after draw with Vet or Medical Certificate Supplied – minus 10%. Scratching after draw with NO Vet or Medical Certificate Supplied - No Refund

Bio-Security & Covid: If your horse is showing any signs of illness, do NOT bring it to the grounds. All competitors must hand in a Horse & Participant Health Declaration on morning of event.

Code of Conduct: PCQ Code of Conduct will be in effect. Bad language, excessive striking of horse, abuse or disrespect to the judge will result in disqualification.

Please note: Callers are not allowed in Combined Training events with the exception of class CT12.

Protests should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and be accompanied by a \$50- fee which is refundable only if protest is upheld.

Disclaimer: Neither the organising committee of this event nor PCAQ accepts any liability for the damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

Reservation of Rights: The organising committee reserves the right to; cancel any class or event, combine or divide classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups, alter advertised times, transfer competitors between sections of a class and to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason.

Cancellation of Event: If for any reason the event is cancelled by the organizing committee prior to the event commencing a 100% refund will be given. If the event is cancelled during the event for any reasons out of the control of the organisers then no refund will be given.

Numbers: all riders are to provide their own numbers – saddle cloth or bridle are preferred.
