Horse/s with signs of illness should not be brought to our grounds.

Competitors are required to advise event organisers if a horse falls ill.

In the unlikely event of a horse movement restriction, everyone will be expected to remain at the venue until cleared to leave. Each participant will be responsible for the care maintenance and cost of their horse/s – including but not limited to feeding, watering and vet costs for the time of restrictions.



## PROTESTS:

Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and should be accompanied by \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.
