ADDITIONAL NOTES:

If there are less than 3 riders in any class, they will be combined as per rules for combined groups. Combined groups: If one or two riders have been nominated for a class, then this group would be combined with the height above or below (one level only). For example, a 90cm class with 80cm or 1mtr.

Seniors can choose the height they wish to jump from Official or Unofficial Classes. They will jump with that group and place as if they are part of that group. However, their points are recorded separately so as not to take a place away from the Under 26 year old riders. Seniors must choose from the Official classes to be eligible for overall awards.

Riders may enter two horses as per PCQ 2026 Rules. Either one or two horses in the Official Section. Either one or two horses in the Unofficial Section.

Run under current PCQ showjumping rule book and PCA national gear rules.

Competitors must be current financial members of PCAQ

Horse Health Declarations (HHD) required on the day of the event – NO HHD NO Ride.

The final responsibility for the suitability of the mount, saddlery and equipment rests with the Rider or their responsible adult (see general rules).

PROTESTS:

Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incidents and should be accompanied by \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS: -

The Organisers reserve the rights:

- (a) To cancel any class or event
- (b) To combine or divide classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups,
- (c) To alter the advertised times
- (d) To refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
- (e) To transfer competitors between sections of a class

BIOSECURITY AND RISK ASSESSMENT PLANS:

In the event of horse movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance, and cost of their horse/horses. Including and not limited to feeding and watering and vet cost for the time of the restriction. An up-to-date BIOSECURITY PLAN and RISK ASSESSMENT PLAN will be available at the Club House.

REFUNDS

No refunds after close of nominations without a vet or medical certificate.
