Rules and Conditions

1. Competitors must be active PCQ Riding members for 2026.
2. Competitors ride at their own risk under the rules of PCQ and PCA gear check rules.
3. All riders **MUST** provide a helper/helpers for the event.
4. The Judges decision is final in all events.
5. **Protests:** Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and should be accompanied by \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.
6. The committee reserves the right to amend the program.
7. All competitors must wear an approved helmet and be suitably attired in Pony Club Uniform.

DISCLAIMER:

Neither the organising committee of this event nor PCAQ accepts any liability for the damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever. The final responsibility for the suitability of the mount, saddlery and equipment rests with the Rider or their responsible adult. (see General Rules)

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS:

The organising committee reserves the right to;

- cancel any class or event,
- divide classes any class,
- combine classes if less than 3 competitors & the rules governing splitting of groups,
- alter advertised times,
- transfer competitors between sections of a class,
- and to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason.

First aid will be in attendance as per the PCA Minimum Medical Requirements.

Draw: Will be emailed to competitors and published on club Facebook Page on Thursday 21st May 2026. Riders will ride 3 dressage tests in total if competing in both dressage and combined training.

Performance cards are required for all official events and must be **prefilled by rider** and handed to the organising secretary prior to the commencement of event.

Riders may enter two horses as per the Two Horse Rule (January 2018)
