Rules

PCQ rules apply

PCA National Gear Rules apply

- Riders may enter **two horses** in the same age group only. The 2nd horse must be held by an unmounted competent person.
- A riders' mount should be the members normal pony club mount and regularly ridden at Pony Club.
- **The final responsibility for the suitability of the mount, saddlery and equipment rests with the Rider or their responsible adult. (See Gear Rules)**
- Gear check is a compliance check as well as a safety check, however, it is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to ensure the safety and compliance of their saddlery and equipment. (see General Rules)
- As with all gear, horse and rider combination must ride at minimum of 2 rally/muster days and be deemed safe by chief instructor.
- The judges'/stewards' decision is final.
- The committee reserves the right to alter the program in any way that may be deemed necessary.
- A senior official from each club to form a Disputes Committee, nominee to be lodged with entries. The committee's decision is final

Protests: Should be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of the event, accompanied by a \$50 fee

Reservation of Rights

The organising committee reserves the right to; cancel any class or event, combine or divide classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups, alter advised times, transfer competitors between sections of a class and to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason

Neither the organising committee of this event nor PCAQ accepts any liability for the damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

Biosecurity

All owners and competitors should be aware that you have a biosecurity obligation to take all reasonable steps to ensure your activities do not spread a pest, disease, or contaminant. No horse with signs of illness is to be brought onto our grounds. Stay home if you are sick. In the event of movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horse/s. Including but not limited to feeding, watering and vet costs for the time of the restriction.
