ABOUT THE DAY

A relaxed and supportive opportunity to practise jumping full courses.

- Perfect if you: Want to try a new height
- Are putting a new horse through a full course
- Are a beginner or less experienced rider wanting to ride a properly built course

Courses will be built by a qualified course builder, with help on hand throughout the day.

HOW IT WORKS

- Ride full showjumping courses
 - Choose to: Ride the same height twice, OR
 - Ride one height, then wait for the course to raise
- No time restrictions – once belled out, the goal is simply to get around the course. Jumps can be adjusted if needed to help you and your horse

HEIGHTS

🕒 Start: 1:00pm with 30cm heights if nominated . Raising in 10cm increments

🏁 Finish: Last rider at 1 metre

💰 \$40 –Per horse Non Pony Club Members
