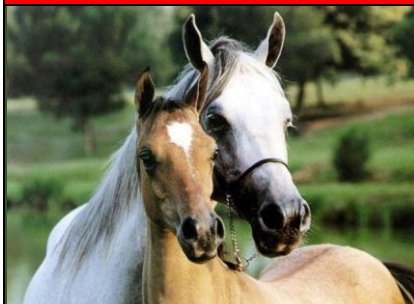

No attachments are permitted on helmets and mobile phones are not to be used whilst on horseback. Riders who are not abiding by the gear check rules in any discipline run the risk of elimination from the class or the whole event.

Riders may enter two horses – each horse to be in full tack (no swapping gear) and held by a competent person. Both horses will be eligible for placings and aggregate awards.

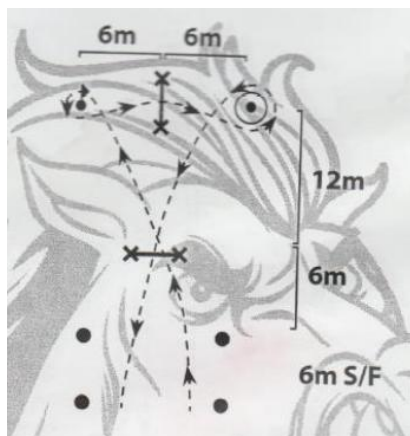

All In One



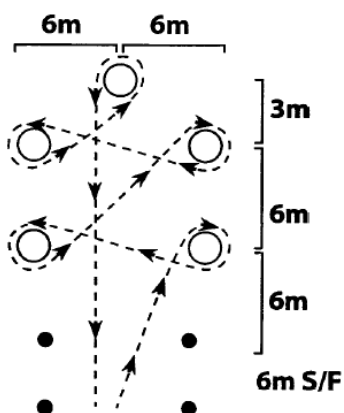
Instructions

Rider proceeds over jump to flag peg turning left and taking flag, gives over second jump places flag in bucket and returns home over first jump. If flag is dropped, rider must dismount, retrieve flag, remount and then continue.

ELIMINATION

1. Knocked peg, jump or drum
2. Wrong course
3. Flag not retrieved if dropped

Jemma's Jungle



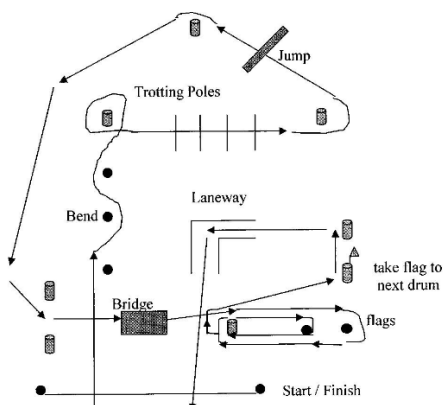
Instructions

Rider starts on right side doing a right turn on first drum crossing over to opposite drum doing a left turn. They then proceed to the second barrel on the right of the course doing a right-hand turn crossing over to the opposite drum doing a left-hand turn. They then proceed to top drum, do a left-hand turn and then ride to finish line. Five seconds added for each drum knocked over.

ELIMINATION

1. Wrong course

Taroom Time Trial



Instructions

Add 5 seconds for each:

- If you canter over trotting poles
- Drop a flag, knock over a peg or drum
- Step outside laneway

Elimination

1. Not crossing the bridge (it cannot be jumped)
2. Incorrect course

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
