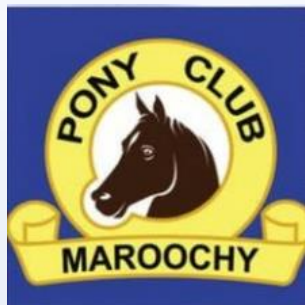

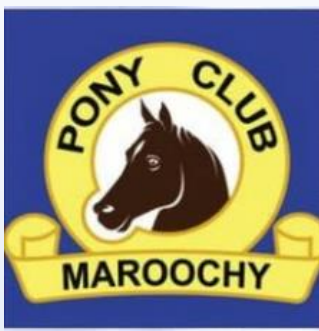

Competition Information & Rules

ALL CLASSES TO BE RUN UNDER CURRENT SHOWJUMPING RULE BOOK AND PCA NATIONAL GEAR BOOK RULES

Two Horse Rule: A competitor may ride two horses in the same or different heights. Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards.

Combined groups – where insufficient entries are received, it will be run as per the combined group rule in the rule book.

Performance Cards - required for all Official Classes, except Seniors. Cards to be handed in before the commencement of the event when checking in.

Numbers – all riders are to provide their own numbers (saddle cloth or bridle preferred).

Disputes – to be lodged with the organising committee member accompanied with \$50 within 30 minutes of the class results being published.

Refunds – scratching before the draw – full refund NOT including Nominate fee

Refunds – scratching after the draw – with vet or Medical Certificate Supplied – a full refund NOT including Nominate fee. There will be no refund if scratching is done after the draw with NO vet or medical certificate.

Camping - \$25 per night

Yards - \$20 per day (\$40 charge if yard is not left clean)

Stables - \$25 per day (\$40 charge if stable is not left clean)

(the above should be booked when nominating)

Biosecurity – if your horse is showing any signs of illness **DO NOT** bring it to the grounds. **All competitors must hand in a Horse Health Declaration** on the morning of the event.

Code of Conduct - PCQ Code of Conduct will be in effect, bad language, excessive striking of horse, abuse or disrespect to the judges/organisers will result in disqualification.

Draw – will be posted to the Maroochy Facebook Event page and emailed to competitors. NO change of class will be permitted after the draw is published.

Cancellation of Event – if for any reason the event is cancelled by the Organising Committee prior to the event commencing a 100% refund will be given, if the event is cancelled during the event for any reason out of the control of the Organisers – no refund will be given.

Ribbons and Points – Ribbons to 5th place in all classes. Points to 10th place

Seniors – Can choose their own height when nominating. There will be two Senior classes to accommodate those riding at 70cm and above (as per the PC rules) and those Seniors riding 40cm to 60cm. The two Senior groups will have their own separate prizes, so those jumping the lower heights are not penalised. All Seniors will be awarded separately in all classes as per rule book.

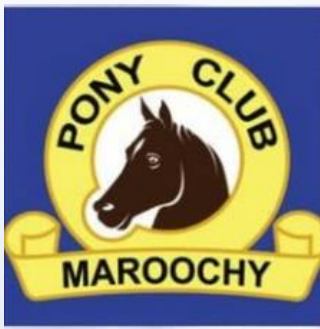
Canteen and Coffee Van – will be open all day Sunday

Numbers – May be capped if necessary

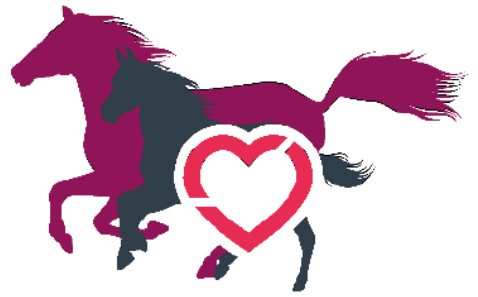
First Aid will be in attendance in accordance with PCA minimal medical requirements

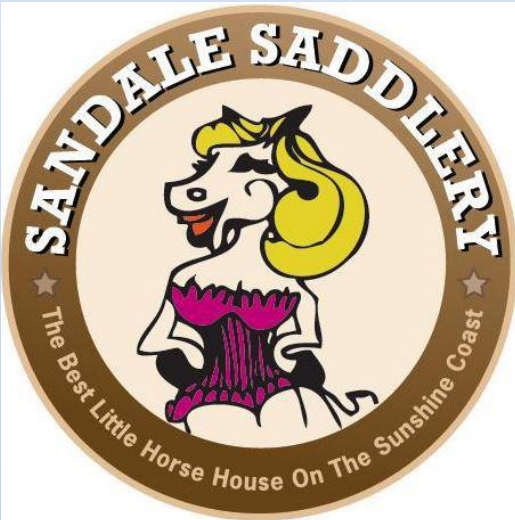
