PCAQ Rules apply to this Event:

Competitors must be current financial members of PCAQ

HELMET Equestrian helmet AS/NZS 3838, EN 1384 or ASTM F1163, with an effective chin strap. Riders with unstamped helmets of the required specification will not be expected to replace them. For competition – only black, brown, navy blue & white are allowed.

The Helmet must be worn whenever mounted under Pony Club supervision, including to & from the Pony Club - this includes seniors & instructors. Candidates at Instructor Schools must wear helmets.

Mounted Voluntary Helpers must wear regulation headgear.

Riders must keep helmets on during Mounted Presentation of Awards & while saluting. FACE

GUARDS Allowed on ASA equestrian helmets.

HELMET COVER Detachable Helmet Covers are permitted in Mounted Games & Cross Country only in combination of shirt and tie colors of club/zone. Black, brown, navy blue and white can be worn in any competition.

SUNSHADE/SUN PROTECTOR Can be worn over or under helmet.

One senior official from each club forms a Dispute Committee, nominees to be lodged with entries. The committee's decision will be final.

All competitors to be in full uniform for presentations please.

Horse Health Declarations (HHD) required on the day of the event - NO HHD NO Ride

Instruction	Score /10
Present to Judge, Salute. walk down centreline to A Long rein	
At A, working trot, At B trot circle to the Right 20m, showing balance, rhythm and even circle	
At B canter Left 20 m Reins in one hand	
At B, Canter right, using Both hands, bend through pegs, leaving first peg on the right. Maintain the canter and lead changes.	
After pegs, hand Gallop Around to C, Showing control of pony and rider's position.	
At C, Downward transition through paces Halt at B.	
Rein back 4 paces, halt.	
Walk forward on Loose rein to M and halt.	
At M dismount, (13 and over will do rein drill), Lead pony to A.	
At A, present yourself and pony to the Judge, wait for acknowledgment, return to troop line.

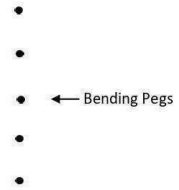

(12 years & under)

Instruction	Score /10
Present to Judge, Salute. walk down centreline to A Long rein	
At A, working trot, At B trot circle to the Right 20m, showing balance, rhythm and even circle	
At B canter Left 20 m using Both hands	
At B, Canter right, using Both hands Bend through pegs, leaving first peg on right. Maintain the canter and lead changes.	
After pegs, continue at Canter to C, showing control of pony and rider's position.	
At C, Downward transition through paces Halt at B.	
Reign back 4 paces, halt.	
Walk forward on Loose rein to M and Halt.	
At M Dismount, (13 and over will do rein drill) Lead pony to A.	
At A present yourself and pony to the Judge, wait for acknowledgement, return to troop
