COST \$5 per round, per horse

- Horses may jump a maximum of 3 rounds, at either the same or consecutive height. If horse enters Open Jumping Rounds AND either Unofficial or Official SJ, this first dot point also applies.
- Open jumping rounds are for training purposes only, they are non-competitive.
- Riders must be current riding members of PCQ or obtain PCQ day membership (\$10).
- Non-PCQ members must comply with PCQ and PCA rules and regulations whilst on club grounds.
- Heights commence at 30 cm, upto 1m + and will increase at 10 cm intervals.
- Horses may compete in Open Jump rounds and either Official or Unofficial SJ.
- Official Show Jumping is only available to Pony Club members.
- Unofficial Show Jumping is open to both Pony Club and non-Pony Club Members.

CAMPING: \$20 per night
Toilet, shower facilities available.

STABLES: \$5.00 per yard, per night.
These are to be booked with your nominations on nominate. Stable allocations will be sent out.
Stables are to be left clean and free of manure and hay or you will be charged a cleaning fee.

SMOKING:
Smoking is not permitted anywhere on the grounds, including the camping area.

DOGS:
Must be securely tied up in camping area.

ELECTRIC SCOOTERS:

RULES & CONDITIONS

RULES

1. Competitors ride at their own risk under the rules of PCQ.
2. ALL riders MUST provide a helper/helpers for the event.
3. The Judge's decision is final in all events.
4. Disputes are to be lodged within 30 minutes of the completion of any event and must be accompanied by a \$50 fee.
5. The committee reserves the right to amend the program.
6. All competitors must wear an approved helmet & be suitably attired in Pony Club uniform.

CONDITIONS

Two horse rule: A competitor may ride two horses in the same or different heights. Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards. The same horse/rider combination is not able to ride in both unofficial and official classes. **Combined groups:** Where insufficient entries are received in a particular class, it will be run as per rules for Combined Groups in the rule book.

Pre-filled Performance Cards: Are required for ALL RIDERS in official classes, except Seniors. Cards are to be presented to the organising committee before the commencement of the event. **Horse Health Declarations:** To be submitted prior to competition to Secretary Office.

Photographs: Attendance at this event constitutes consent to being photographed or filmed for use on Zone 27 and associated clubs' social media and promotional materials unless otherwise advised to the event secretary. Those who do not permit their photo being taken must provide written advice to the secretary prior to the event.
