RULES AND CONDITIONS:

1. Competitors ride at their own risk under the rules of PCAQ.
2. The Judge's decision is final in ALL events.
3. The Committee reserves the right to amend the program.
4. All competitors must wear an approved helmet and be suitably attired in Pony Club Uniform.
5. All official competitors will ride HC if they don't hand in a Performance Card
6. Two Horse Rule: Riders may enter two horses in the same or different classes. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS: The organising committee reserves the right to; cancel any class or event, combine or divide classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups, alter advertised times, transfer competitors between sections of a class and to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason.

DISCLAIMER:

Neither the organising committee of this event nor PCAQ accepts any liability for the damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

The final responsibility for the suitability of the mount, saddlery and equipment rests with the Rider or their responsible adult. (see General Rules)

PROTESTS: Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and should be accompanied by \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

PCAQ Rules apply to this Event:

Competitors must be current financial members of PCAQ

HELMET: Equestrian helmet AS/NZS 3838, EN 1384 or ASTM F1163, with an effective chin strap

Riders with unstamped helmets of the required specification will not be expected to replace them.

For competition – only black, brown, navy blue & white are allowed.

The Helmet must be worn whenever mounted under Pony Club supervision, including to and from the Pony Club - this includes seniors & instructors. Candidates at Instructor Schools must wear helmets.

Mounted Voluntary Helpers must wear the regulation headgear.

Riders must keep helmets on during Mounted Presentation of Awards & while saluting.

FACE GUARDS: Allowed on ASA equestrian helmets.

HELMET COVER: Detachable Helmet Covers are permitted in Mounted Games & Cross Country only in combination of shirt and tie colours of club/zone. Black, brown, navy blue and white can be worn in any competition.

SUNSHADE/SUN PROTECTOR: Can be worn over or under helmet.

One senior official from each club to form a Dispute Committee, nominee to be lodged with entries. The committee's decision will be final.

COMPETITION DAY: Clubs are to supply 1 worker for each 3 riders or part thereof on the day of the competition.

PROTESTS: Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and should be accompanied by \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

HORSE & PARTICIPANT HEALTH DECLARATIONS: (HPHD) required on the day of the event - **NO HPHD NO Ride**

**One senior official from each club to form a Dispute Committee, nominee to be lodged with entries.
